IMPORTANT. PLEASE READ THIS BEFORE BEGINNING TO COLLECT SIGNATURES.

Instructions for Those Collecting Signatures on Petitions

It is important that we are careful of the manner in which we collect signatures if our campaign is to gain public credibility and is to be taken seriously by state legislators and the press. Please strictly observe the following rules when collecting signatures.

- Only North Carolina residents who will be at least 18 years old on or before November 6, 2018 can sign the petition.
- Each petition sheet must include people living in one county only. That county must be written at the bottom of each sheet in the line provided.
- Help each person who signs by reminding them to write slowly and legibly. The signatures will be wasted if the printed names, addresses and contact information cannot be deciphered.
- Make sure each person fills out all necessary fields on the petition, including signature, printed name, date, street address, city, state and zip code. Phone and email address are optional, but should be encouraged.
- Write your own name (the signature collector) in the space provided at the bottom of each sheet of signatures you collect.
- Petitions should always be accompanied by someone responsible for collecting the signatures. They should not be left in a public place for people to sign by chance. They can be stolen or vandalized and the names of those who sign will be lost to the campaign.
